

Q2 2026 Dividend Growth Update

Reaves Utility Income Fund owned 69 common stocks as of 6/30/26, 51 of which paid a cash dividend in Q2 2026. In the past 12 months, 44 companies increased their dividend, six maintained the same payment, and one company initiated a dividend. The adjusted weighted average* dividend increase was 5.5%.

**Deutsche Telekom and Cameco Corp pay their dividends on an annual basis. The dividends shown for these two companies in the table above have been adjusted for comparison purposes. The weighted average increase was adjusted downward from 9.3% to 5.5% by excluding the impact of GE Vernova's 100% increase.*
